Improvised Plays Unleash Dreams and Nightmares in “Lynch” At Edinburgh Fringe

From Seattle, Washington’s vibrant improv scene comes **Lynch: Improvised Plays in the Style of David Lynch**, a brand new show at this year’s Free Fringe Festival. Every performance features the spontaneous exploration of a dream or an object suggested by a member of the audience, and a totally unique one-act is created.

Enter a world with its veil drawn back, where good and evil battle in darkly comedic style; where everyday emotions run higher than even a mid-day soap opera; where the bright shiny exterior of Americana cracks open to reveal the often dark underbelly underneath. Enter a world celebrating the style of David Lynch.

“I’ve always been captivated watching shiny artifice butt up against reality’s darker nature,” says director Elizabeth Brammer. “So much of today’s world is image juxtaposed with emotion, and exploring pure hope and fear through dream logic is endlessly relevant. There’s comedy playing in genre improvisation, but only with the dedication to embracing style and theme and emotion – never at its expense.”
