The Lives of the Audience Become the Show in Improvised Solo Comedy Returning to Edinburgh Fringe

American performer Peter Michael Marino returns to Edinburgh Festival Fringe with his semi-improvised, semi-scripted, entirely-unpredictable solo comedy, 'Show Up.'

Following critically acclaimed, sold-out runs in NYC, Toronto, Boston, and the 2017 Edinburgh Fringe, this one-man, interactive spin on the traditional solo show is all about the challenges and triumphs of the audience – who provide their own astonishing life-changing events from family fallouts to love life catastrophes to job disasters. Within moments, Marino creates a solo comedy show tailor-made for that audience, who also lend a hand in the set and sound design. And, there's a party!

Peter Michael Marino has been creating solo shows for over 20 years, including a two-year, international run of 'Desperately Seeking the Exit' – his comedy about the making and unmaking of his West End Blondie/Madonna flop, 'Desperately Seeking Susan.' When he ran out of real-life experiences to write about, while simultaneously battling his own mental health issues, Marino needed to create something.

"I knew I had to devise a new show to keep me sane. If I'm not doing something all the time, I'm totally lost," says Marino. "So, why not make the show about the audience for a change?" The result is 'Show Up.'

Every show is different; drawing on the timeless tropes of the solo genre, while also comically delving into Pete's own social anxiety and depression struggles. It's a comedy.
